Lav nedenstående sætninger om til **præteritum** (datid)

Bemærk, at 'must' sjældent bruges i datid. I stedet bruger man 'had to'.

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| 1. Can you hear him? | Could you hear him? |
| 2. She can't speak Chinese. | She couldn't speak Chinese. |
| 3. It may be true. | It might be true. |
| 4. I must know the truth. | I had to know the truth. |
| 5. I will win that match! | I would win that match! |
| 6. They will go shopping tomorrow. | They would go shopping the next day. |
| 7. He ought to pay the whole amount. | He ought to pay the whole amount. |

Lav nedenstående sætninger om til **perfektum** (førnutid):

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| 1. I can speak Russian. | I have been able to speak Russian. |
| 2. I may borrow his phone. | I have been allowed to borrow his phone. |
| 3. We must sell our car. | We have had to sell our car. |
| 4. The company ought to pay. | The company has been obliged to pay. |
| 5. He can't find the money. | He has not been able to find the money. |
| 6. She must stop smoking. | She has had to stop smoking. |

Infinitiv (navneform): Oversæt nedenstående sætninger til engelsk:

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| 1. Det er godt at kunne tale engelsk. | It is good to be able to speak English. |
| 2. Skulle de have lov til at blive? | Should they be allowed to stay? |
| 3. Er det OK at ville være berømt? | Is it OK to want to be famous? |
