Simpel tid

Nutid / Præsens (bor)

I live	
you live	
he / she / it lives	She / Henry / the man <i>lives</i> in Birmingham. The man who <i>lives</i> next door..... The editor <i>publishes</i> the book. The movie <i>starts</i> at 8 o'clock.
we live	My sister and I <i>live</i> in Brighton.
you live	I have heard that you and your brother <i>live</i> in Paris.
they live	Tom and his sister <i>live</i> in Hamburg. The parents <i>live</i> in London.

Datid / Præteritum (boede)

Det hedder *lived*, uanset hvilken person der er tale om.

Førnutid / Perfektum (har boet)

I have lived
you have lived
he / she / it **has** lived
we have lived
you have lived
they have lived

Førdatid / Pluskvamperfektum (havde boet)

had lived (i alle personer)

Udvidet tid (ING-form)

What you are doing right now?

Nutid / Præsens

I am cooking
you are cooking
he / she / it is cooking
we are cooking
you are cooking
they are cooking

What were you doing yesterday at 7 o'clock?

Datid / Præteritum

I was cooking
you were cooking
he / she / it was cooking
we were cooking
you were cooking
they were cooking
