## Kort oversigt over de vigtigste tider

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### Simpel tid

#### Nutid / Præsens (bor)

I live	I <b>live</b> in Copenhagen.
you live	You <b>live</b> in New York.
he / she / it <b>lives</b>	She / Henry / the man <b>lives</b> in Birmingham. The man who <b>lives</b> next door..... The editor <b>publishes</b> the book. The movie <b>starts</b> at 8 o'clock.
we live	My sister and I <b>live</b> in Brighton.
you live	I have heard that you and your brother <b>live</b> in Paris.
they live	Tom and his sister <b>live</b> in Hamburg. The parents <b>live</b> in London.

#### Datid / Præteritum (boede)

Det hedder **lived**, uanset hvilken person der er tale om: Last year she **lived** in Rome.

#### Førnutid / Perfektum (har boet)

I **have lived**  
you have lived  
he / she / it **has lived**  
we have lived  
you have lived  
they have lived

#### Førdatid / Pluskvamperfektum (havde boet)

**had lived** (i alle personer)

### Udvidet tid (ING-form)

What you are doing right now?

#### Nutid / Præsens

I **am cooking** (**jeg er ved at** lave mad)  
you are cooking  
he / she / it is cooking  
we are cooking  
you are cooking  
they are cooking

What were you doing yesterday at 7 o'clock?

#### Datid / Præteritum

I **was cooking** (**jeg var ved at** lave mad)  
you were cooking  
he / she / it was cooking  
we were cooking  
you were cooking  
they were cooking
