The man **who** lives next door... (den mand, som bor inde ved siden af.../ den mand, der bor ...)

Oh, it's just my cat **who** is knocking on the door (kæledyr)

WHICH bruges om ting, begreber og dyr generelt:

The star **which** you see over there... (den stjerne, som du kan se derovre...)

In India we saw a tiger **which** came from the nearby forest (dyr generelt)
